

DECISION BT C172/2022

Subject: Handling of BT decisions not approved by correspondence

BT,

- having noted
 - the series of measures for the 'Simplification of governance' as in decision BT C011/2021 & D168/C009;
 - in particular, the measure on operational management that reads: 'the deferred decisions following BT voting/consultation must be treated in a way to ensure a timely solution, thus without waiting, by default, for the next meeting. The following criteria applies: if the BT meeting is 5 or less weeks– with a minimum of two weeks - after closure of the BT voting/consultation, the topic goes to the upcoming BT meeting by default; if the BT meeting is more than 5 weeks away after closure of the BT voting/consultation, a solution is sought by correspondence unless the BT member/PD who submitted the deferral explicitly requests that the item goes to the meeting';
 - the need to further clarify the process when a solution is to be sought by correspondence;
 - the proposal put forward by CLC/BTWG 128-3 and presented in the CEN-CLC/BTWG 14 meeting of 6 July 2022;
- considering the process as in Annex 1 to this document which included the additional comments received by BTWG 14 members;
- decided to approve the process for the handling of BT decisions deferred/not approved by correspondence as in Annex 1.
