

## **RESOLUTION BT 4/2010**

**Subject:** CEN approach on addressing environmental issues in product and service standards

BT:

- endorses the 'CEN approach on addressing environmental issues in product and service standards' as described in document BT N 8369;
- referring to clause 2.1 of this document (priorities) stresses its wish to be kept fully informed of the priorities set and the membership of ENIS twice a year;
- referring to clause 2.3.5 of the document, requests CEN Technical/Project Committees to review regularly their title and scope in view of not excluding environmental issues from their work, especially for those TCs/PCs where title and/or scope are limited to a specific aspect e.g. safety;
- asks CEN/EHD to regularly report on the results of the implementation of the CEN approach and the actual uptake of environmental aspects by Technical Committees;
- requests CCMC to include the 'CEN approach on addressing environmental issues in product and service standards' as a Guidance Document in BOSS;
- invites CENELEC/BT to agree to jointly consider how to harmonize the approach to the integration of environmental aspects in standardization.
