

RESOLUTION BT 7/2006

Subject: ISO/TS and ISO/TR, and Vienna Agreement

BT/TCMG, on behalf of BT,

- referring to Resolutions BT 41/1997 and BT C186/2000;
- considering that
 - the transposition of an ISO publication into a CEN/TS or CEN/TR leads to approval and administrative procedures and does not result in principle in added value;
 - the transposition of a CEN/TS or CEN/TR into an ISO publication appears to be useful as it makes (provisional) European solutions available worldwide;
- welcomes the application of parallel approval procedures in ISO and CEN of Technical Specifications or Technical Reports under CEN lead;
- confirms that the transposition of an ISO publication into a CEN/TS or CEN/TR, either through a parallel approval procedure in ISO and CEN or through the submission of the published ISO publication to vote in CEN, is to be considered as an exception, and that consequently, any request for such a transposition must be fully justified and submitted to the BT for decision on a case by case basis.

This Resolution replaces Resolution BT 41/1997.
