

RESOLUTION BT 16/2006

Subject: BT/CAG 172 – Technical work in enlarged CEN (Follow up of Resolution BT 21/2005) – Proposal to introduce ‘twinning’ into the CEN System

BT,

- adopts the BT CAG 172 recommendations as detailed in BT N 7584,
- agrees that a CEN/TC may appoint one Vice-Chairman. In addition to responsibilities of the role agreed with the officers and members of the CEN/TC, the Vice-Chairman should have a special responsibility to encourage participation of countries in the work of the CEN/TC that are under-represented,
- agrees that two CEN members may enter a twinning arrangement in the management of a secretariat to a CEN/TC, subject to notification of the twinning agreement to CMC,
- asks CMC to prepare a guidance document on the implementation of twinning arrangements in CEN for inclusion in the BOSS based on the more detailed report of BT CAG 172 and comments made in the BT meeting,
- asks CMC and BT members to ensure that these arrangements are cascaded to officers of the CEN/TCs.
