RESOLUTION BT 30/1999 (revised)

Subject: Corrigenda and Correction letters

BT/TCMG, on behalf of BT,

- considering the concerns of members about the number of Corrigenda and Correction letters issues by CS, causing additional costs at NSB level;
- noting the IR part 2 clause 4.9 about the possibilities for updating of European standards;
- noting the information provided by the CS which indicates that the number and methodology for Corrigenda and Correction letters has not changed significantly;
- reminding that "corrigenda" and "correction letters" are used for editorial corrections only;
- requests BT members to raise awareness at TC secretariat level and at all
 - stages of the standard's development process, for this aspect of quality of
 - European standards and related national costs;
- notes that considerable benefits could be derived from a review of the translation procedure principles;
- strongly supports that the use of Corrigenda and Correction letters should
 be limited to up to 3 years after publication;
- reminding that "corrigenda" and "correction letters" are used for editorial corrections only.
