

## **RESOLUTION BT 87/1993 Revision 1**

**Subject:** A-deviations in European Standards

BT asks the Technical Committees to do their utmost in preparing European Standards in order that A-deviations are not necessary. Should, in exceptional cases, A-deviations to European Standards reflecting an existing national situation even in fields covered by EC Directives be necessary, BT reconfirms the procedure to be followed as given in Resolution BT 3/1993 stressing that these A-deviations do not form part of the European Standards and, in case there are, have to be attached to ENs as an informative annex.

BT also stresses that "classes" can be used in European Standards, but these would not necessarily eliminate A-deviations.
