

## **Derogation from standstill - Checklist**

The request for derogation from standstill by a CEN member is considered when the following criteria are fulfilled:

- the reasoning of the request and supporting documentation are available;
- the CEN work item(s) number(s) or the reference(s) of the published European Standard(s) which are affected, their progress status and the relationship with '98/34' standstill are well defined;
- the national draft standard references concerned (i.e. number, title, scope, date) and their intended changes are well defined;
- the commitment of the CEN National Member to withdraw its standard and to replace it by the corresponding EN, when available, as well as the declaration that the national foreword will contain a reference to the prEN are recorded.

The decision for approval of derogation from standstill by the CEN/TC is considered when the following criteria are affirmatively fulfilled:

- the whole relevant documentation is available;
- the request is really a case subject to derogation from standstill;
- the request refers to an exceptional case.

The decision shall be taken by weighted vote.
